

## Neuköllner Kunstpreis 2021

### Conditions of submission

The culture department of the Neukölln district office donates in cooperation with KulturNetzwerk Neukölln e. V. and STADT UND LAND Wohnbauten Gesellschaft mbH an art award for artists based in Berlin-Neukölln. The aim of this project is to bring the artistic quality of Neukölln artists closer to a wider public and to strengthen the local art artists. The award winners and the artists nominated for the award are determined in a transparent process: KulturNetzwerk Neukölln e.V. appoints an expert jury with independent representatives of the Berlin art scene.

**The Neukölln Art Prize is endowed with a total of 6,000 Euro, which is structured as follows:**

1st prize: 3,000 Euro

2nd prize: 2,000 Euro

3rd prize: 1,000 Euro

**The application period begins on September 1st, 2020 and ends on October 31st, 2020, applications are only possible in digital form at [www.anmeldung.art-spaces-nk.de](http://www.anmeldung.art-spaces-nk.de)**

### Conditions of participation

Artists who have completed an artistic training and / or who can provide evidence of several years of artistic activity in the arts field, have lived in Neukölln for at least six months or have their own studio, can apply. For the application for the Neukölln Art Prize, an existing work must be proposed that represents the working methods of the respective participants and must not be older than 3 years. The jury meets in mid-November. **It evaluates the individual work in the context of the overall work (portfolio)**

### Required Documents

- Documentation of **one** artistic work (possibly also multi-part) from the last 3 years (digital photo as JPEG, at least 10 x 15 cm, 300 dpi) as a proposal for the nominee exhibition, including information on material and size
- Statement on the artistic approach of the proposed work, brief description of the working technique / working method (max. 1200 characters)
- Portfolio / catalog (max. 10 MB), as PDF

- Meaningful artistic curriculum vitae / biographical information, max. 2 MB, as PDF
- The later nominees must prove their place of residence in Neukölln or their own studio in Neukölln.

### **Nominees exhibition**

The eight artists nominated by the jury for the Neukölln Art Prize are obliged to present their work as part of an eight-week group exhibition in the gallery in the hall. A work must therefore be proposed for the application that is available during the exhibition period (probably from January 24th to March 29th, 2020). The work must not exceed the following dimensions: Floor work or sculptures: 4 m<sup>2</sup>; wall-bound works: 6 m<sup>2</sup>. If a proposed work cannot be shown in the exhibition room for technical reasons or if another work is more suitable from a curatorial point of view, this can be requested.

The work is to be delivered and picked up at the expense and risk of the applicant. All works have to be stable enough to withstand the unavoidable stresses of an exhibition company, even with careful handling.

### **Award ceremony**

The award winners will be announced during the official award ceremony in Heimathafen Neukölln in the context of the exhibition opening (gallery in the hall).

### **Additional notes and conditions**

#### **Image rights to the submitted works**

Should the Kulturnetzwerk Neukölln e. V. or the Department of Culture intend to publish an art publication of the competition entries, the free transfer of the right of reproduction through participation is deemed to have been agreed. This also applies to publications on the Internet. The author of the reproduction (photographer) must be named by the artist.

The organizer is authorized to transfer the right of reproduction to the press, television or specialist magazines, insofar as this appears necessary for the publication of the competition result and for the public dissemination of the exhibition.

#### **Insurance**

The works of art are insured during the exhibition and during transport, provided that the sales price and insurance value have been communicated in good time for the insurance to be taken out. The conditions of the exhibition insurance taken out apply. The organizer does not assume any liability beyond the insurance cover. In addition, the provisions of the German Civil Code apply. The place of fulfillment and jurisdiction is Berlin.
